Have you ever experienced something and you simply couldn't get the image out of your mind? That has happened to me a few times in my life. I have experienced a few auto accidents both as driver and passenger, and those images are etched in my memory. I have been called upon in some tragic deaths and those memories are still clear to me. The most recent image playing in my mind is from Confirmation Sunday. We had thirteen students who were ready to profess Jesus as Lord. The images that keep coming back are the four baptisms. Reid Hensley kneeling on the prayer rail and Jake Barrett, Jackson Powell, and Paige Rawlinson who chose immersion in the sacred stock tank. These young people made a public profession and were baptized in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. I remember the face of each one as the water touched them. Through baptism, these students are marked by Jesus for his kingdom. This is the beginning of a new life in Christ. As I remember all the students on Confirmation Sunday, I began to be in awe as I thought about all that led to just that moment. The parents, grandparents, pastors, Sunday School teachers, Vacation Bible School leaders, youth directors, mentors and guides who have helped shape the faith of each one.

We do not come to faith in isolation. Rather, we come to faith in community. The faith community of First United Methodist Church takes this role seriously.

I cannot get these baptisms out of my mind. I look forward to what God is doing in the lives of the younger children and what God is working in the lives of those who have already stood before us and said, "Jesus is Lord."

Lord, thank you for imprinting the image of baptism on my mind. I ask that you never let me tire of being part of and supporting people who are ready to give their lives to Jesus, our Lord. Amen.
